FOLDED ARTICLES TO BE PLACED WITH SMOOTH EDGE FACING OUT. SHOES AND SNEAKERS TO BE LACED AT ALL TIMES. ALL ARTICLES IN ONE SECTION, ie: T-SHIRTS, SHORTS, ETC., TO BE FOLDED SAME SIZE. ALL GARMENTS TO BE FULLY BUTTONED AT ALL TIMES. WHEN HANGING UNIFORM PARTS -FOLLOWING SEQUENCE TO BE FOLLOWED FROM RIGHTS TO LEFT (AS YOU FACE THE LOCKER) RAINCOAT - LONGEST OUTER GARMENTS - OTHER OUTER GARMENTS - PANTS UNDER SHIRTS. RIGHT SHOULDER OF GARMENTS FACING INSPECTION OFFICER.
